- Develop performance measurement and metrics

During the Workshop, diverse representatives from government, academia, and the private sector will have the opportunity to review and provide input into key recommendations to the draft report *Federal R&D Priorities for Net Zero Energy, High Performance Green Buildings* as well as related high priority federally funded R&D activities in buildings technology. In addition, participants will discuss strategies for ongoing and expanded collaboration among all stakeholders.
