JOB SUMMARY:

This position is located in the Building and Fire Research Laboratory (BFRL) of the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) in Gaithersburg, Maryland.

The candidate will conduct research on the integration of building design, engineering, construction, operations and maintenance information systems and on the development of test suites for testing interoperability specifications related to building and construction information systems.

This position is open to all qualified U. S. citizens; non-status candidates. However, we have also opened a vacancy for status candidates, vacancy announcement number BFRL-2008-0038. PROMOTION POTENTIAL: The full performance level of this position is ZP-IV (GS-13/14).

This position is covered by an Alternative Personnel Management System (APMS). This system replaced the General Schedule pay plan (GS) and its grade structure. Under the APMS system, positions are designated by career path and pay band. The ZP-III level is equivalent to the GS-11/12 grade levels, and the ZP-IV level is equivalent to the GS-13/14 grade levels.

NIST's unique Alternative Personnel Management System (APMS) <http://www.nist.gov/hrmd/apms.htm>, which replaced the Federal GS Pay Plan and structure at NIST, allows us the flexibility to offer higher salaries not available in most other Federal agencies.

Moreover, employees are eligible to receive an annual pay increase and bonus based upon performance.
